Simply complete the attached application and mail with a voided check to NCB. You can also fax the application with a copy of your voided check to (703) 647-3471.

How Does QuickPay Work?

QuickPay will deduct the amount of your monthly payment from your bank account on the draft date you select. QuickPay does not give NCB access to any of your bank balances. The payment simply moves electronically from your bank to ours.

How Will I Know When QuickPay is Activated?

It usually takes between 30 and 60 days to set up QuickPay. We will send you a postcard letting you know that QuickPay has been activated.

Who Do I Call with Questions?

If you have questions about QuickPay, please call the Account Representative listed on the attached business card. If you have any questions regarding an upcoming payment, please contact us at least five (5) business days prior to the payment due date.

Can I Cancel QuickPay?

Yes. To cancel QuickPay at any time, simply notify your Account Representative.
